

ORDINANCE NO. 4668

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 126, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 2, SECTION 126-717, OF THE BOSSIER PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES “R-1 ONE-FAMILY RESIDENCE DISTRICTS”, WITHIN THE FIVE-MILE JURISDICTION OF THE BENTON-PARISH METROPOLITAN PLANNING COMMISSION, TO ADD AND/OR AMEND CERTAIN SECTIONS OR SUBSECTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session on this 20th day of December, 2017, that Chapter 126, Article III, Division 2, Section 126-717 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinances, be and is hereby amended to add Subsection (b)(1), as follows:

Section 126-717 (b)(1) is hereby amended to add the following use:

Horse and Poultry Raising the keeping of “horses” and “poultry”, which need not be enclosed in a structure. The keeping of livestock other than horses and poultry is prohibited. This permitted use shall only be allowed within multi-lot subdivision developments which are comprised of lots in which the minimum size of each individual lot is no less than 2 acres in area. The type and quantity of each animal must be governed by the covenants and restrictions of the particular development. The Planning Commission, officers, agents and employees thereof are not responsible for any enforcement actions that may arise from this ordinance, and any liability resulting from the keeping of horses and poultry which are the responsibility of the individual homeowners of the particular development.

The ordinance was offered by Ms. Bennett, seconded by Mr. Cochran. The motion carried and was duly adopted on this 20th day of December, 2017, with the following vote recorded:
