

ORDINANCE NO. 4614

WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on the 1st day of June, 2016, has received a request from Specialty Trackhoe & Dozer Service, Inc., and David Lawler Construction, Inc., that the parish accept into its system for permanent maintenance, the streets and drainage in Belmere Subdivision, Unit No. 2, Bossier Parish, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the said streets and drainage have been completed in accordance with the specifications of the Bossier Parish Police Jury; and

WHEREAS, two-year maintenance bonds have been executed in favor of the Bossier Parish Police Jury to guarantee against failure of said streets and drainage as to material and workmanship as required by Chapter 110, Section 110-201 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinance.

WHEREAS, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Bossier Parish Police Jury that it does accept two-year maintenance bonds of Specialty Trackhoe & Dozer Service, Inc., and David Lawler Construction, Inc., including labor and materials, for the above captioned streets and drainage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bossier Parish Police Jury does hereby accept into the parish maintenance system for continuous maintenance, streets and drainage located in Belmere Subdivision, Unit No. 2, Bossier Parish, Louisiana:

Cameron Circle – 0.106 mile
St. Andrews Lane – 0.069 mile

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, together with the two maintenance bonds.

The Ordinance was offered by Mr. Skaggs, seconded by Mr. Cook. Upon vote, it was duly adopted on this 1st day of June, 2016.
