

ORDINANCE NO. 4615

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 86 OF THE BOSSIER PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 86-2, "SOLICITATION UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCE GOING DOOR TO DOOR AND/OR STREET TO STREET AND PANHANDLING ANYWHERE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE PARISH", TO ADD AND/OR AMEND CERTAIN SECTIONS OR SUBSECTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2016, that Chapter 86, Section 86-2, (a)(1), be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 86-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 86-2. Solicitation Upon Private Residence Going Door to Door and/or Street to Street and Panhandling Anywhere in the Unincorporated Areas of the Parish.

(a) Annual License Required.

- (1) All peddlers, as defined by R.S. 47:342(8), going door to door and/or street to street, and anyone panhandling anywhere in the unincorporated areas of Bossier Parish shall obtain an annual license costing \$100.00, which shall expire one year from the date of issue, from the Bossier Parish Police Jury located at the Bossier Parish Courthouse, 204 Burt Blvd., Benton, LA.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Plummer, seconded by Mr. Skaggs. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2016.
