

ORDINANCE NO. 4739

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 102, SECTION 1, OF THE BOSSIER PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES OF BOSSIER PARISH, LOUISIANA, "SOLID WASTE" TO ADD SUBSECTION (F) TO ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR PERSONAL PROPERTY ABANDONED DUE TO EVICTION, BOSSIER PARISH, LOUISIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session on this 2nd day of October, 2019, that Chapter 102, Section 1 be and is hereby amended to add Subsection (f) as follows:

Section 102-1. Dumping refuse along roads, bridges, highways, waterways or adjacent areas.

(f) It shall be unlawful for any property owner, or their acting agent, to deposit any trash, rubbish, furniture, household goods, clothing, or any other materials removed from the residence during the eviction process, in the rights-of-way except for the main public entrance of the property. Any property owner who does not have the means to remove the evicted tenant's personal property may contact the Parish Highway Department which will provide a truck and trailer to remove the personal property. The Parish shall charge the property owner an upfront fee of \$500.00 for the service. The property owner must supply the manpower to load the personal property into the trailer. The personal property will be stored at a designated impound yard, unprotected from the elements for five (5) business days. Any unclaimed property will be disposed of after five (5) business days.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Benton, seconded by Mr. Plummer. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 2nd day of October, 2019.
