

ORDINANCE NO. 4811

WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2020, has received a request from Benton & Brown, LLC, that the parish accept into its system for permanent maintenance, the streets and drainage in Willow Creek at Benton Subdivision, Unit No. 2; and

WHEREAS, the said streets and drainage have been completed in accordance with the specifications of the Bossier Parish Police Jury; and

WHEREAS, a two-year maintenance bond has been executed in favor of the Bossier Parish Police Jury to guarantee against failure of said streets and drainage as to material and workmanship as required by Chapter 110, Section 110-201 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinance.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury that it does accept the two-year maintenance bond of Benton & Brown, LLC, including labor and materials, for the above captioned streets and drainage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bossier Parish Police Jury does hereby accept into the parish maintenance system for continuous maintenance, streets and drainage located in Willow Creek at Benton Subdivision, Unit No. 2, Bossier Parish, Louisiana:

East Hartline – 0.287 miles

West Hartline – 0.111 miles

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, together with the maintenance bond.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Rodgers, seconded by Mr. Skaggs. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2020.
