

ORDINANCE NO. 4858

WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on the 15th day of September, 2021, has received a request from 3 Gen Construction, LLC, that the parish hereby accept into its system for permanent maintenance West Linton Road, Bossier Parish, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the said West Linton Road has been completed in accordance with the specifications of the Bossier Parish Police Jury; and

WHEREAS, a two-year maintenance bond has been executed in favor of the Bossier Parish Police Jury to guarantee against failure of said West Linton Road as to material and workmanship as required by Chapter 110, Section 110-201 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinance.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury that it does accept the two-year maintenance bond of 3 Gen Construction, LLC, including labor and materials, for the above captioned West Linton Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bossier Parish Police Jury does hereby accept into the parish maintenance system for continuous maintenance West Linton Road, Bossier Parish, Louisiana:

West Linton Road – 0.564 miles

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, together with a copy of the recorded Contract Agreement and maintenance bond filed May 27, 2020, and recorded as Instrument No. 1234471 in the Office of the Clerk of Court, Bossier Parish, Louisiana,

The Ordinance was offered by Mr. Rodgers, seconded by Mr. Marsiglia. Upon vote, it was duly adopted on this 15th day of September, 2021.
