

ORDINANCE NO. 5042

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5031 OF OCTOBER 2, 2024, WHICH ADOPTED AD VALOREM ADJUSTED MILLAGE RATES, TO CORRECT AND CHANGE A CLERICAL ERROR FROM THE REASSESSMENT PROCESS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury of the Parish of Bossier, State of Louisiana, in a public meeting held on October 2, 2024, and conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution, and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the following adjusted millages rates be and they are hereby levied upon the dollar of the assessed valuation of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within said Parish for the year 2024, for the purpose of raising revenue:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Assessor of the Parish of Bossier, shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 2024 the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with the law.

The foregoing ordinance was read in full, and the roll was called on the adoption thereof. Upon unanimous vote of the Bossier Parish Police Jury, each of the aforementioned adjusted tax millage rates for the year 2024, considered and adopted on the 2nd day of October, 2024, are hereby ratified and approved, as corrected, on this 6th day of November, 2024.
