

ORDINANCE NO. 5043

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5032 OF OCTOBER 2, 2024, WHICH ADOPTED AD VALOREM ADJUSTED MILLAGE RATES AND INCREASED THE MILLAGE RATE(S), BUT NOT IN EXCESS OF THE PRIOR YEAR'S MAXIMUM RATE(S), TO CORRECT AND CHANGE A CLERICAL ERROR FROM THE REASSESSMENT PROCESS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury of the Parish of Bossier, State of Louisiana, in a public meeting held on October 2, 2024, and conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution, and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the taxing district voted to increase the millage rate(s), but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rate(s), on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2024, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rates are:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Assessor of the Parish of Bossier, shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 2024 the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with the law.

The foregoing ordinance was read in full, and the roll was called on the adoption thereof. Upon unanimous vote of the Bossier Parish Police Jury, each of the aforementioned adjusted tax millage rates for the year 2024, considered and adopted on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2024, are hereby ratified and approved, as corrected, on this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024.
