

ORDINANCE NO. 5050

WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on the 20th day of November, 2024, has received a request from LP Development, LLC, that the parish accept the streets and drainage in Edgewater Pass Unit No. 1, Phase 2, into its system for permanent maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the said streets and drainage have been completed in accordance with the specifications of the Bossier Parish Police Jury; and

WHEREAS, a two-year maintenance bond has been executed in favor of the Bossier Parish Police Jury to guarantee against failure of said streets and drainage as to material and workmanship as required by Chapter 110, Section 110-201 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinances.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Bossier Parish Police Jury that it does accept the two-year maintenance bond of Bowman Grading and Asphalt, Inc., in the amount of \$36,703.13, including labor and materials, for the following streets and storm drainage:

Prien Lake Loop – 0.149 miles

Feery Lake Drive – 0.023 miles

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, together with the maintenance bond.

The Ordinance was offered by Ms. Parks, seconded by Mr. Rimmer. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 20th day of November, 2024.
