

ORDINANCE NO. 5029

WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on the 18th day of September, 2024, has received a request from Bowman Grading and Asphalt, Inc., that the parish accept Safe Harbor Drive into its system for permanent maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the said streets and drainage have been completed in accordance with the specifications of the Bossier Parish Police Jury; and

WHEREAS, a two-year maintenance bond has been executed in favor of the Bossier Parish Police Jury to guarantee against failure of said streets and drainage as to material and workmanship as required by Chapter 110, Section 110-201 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinances.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Bossier Parish Police Jury that it does accept the two-year maintenance bond of Bowman Grading and Asphalt, Inc. in the amount of \$114,408.60, including labor and materials, for the following street and storm drainage:

Safe Harbor Drive – 0.191 miles

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bossier Parish Police Jury does hereby accept Safe Harbor Drive, Bossier Parish, LA, into the parish maintenance system for continuous maintenance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, together with the maintenance bond.

The Ordinance was offered by Mr. Marsiglia, seconded by Mr. Jorden. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 18th day of September, 2024.
