

ORDINANCE NO. 5040

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON VETERANS PARKWAY LOCATED IN SECTIONS 13, 23, 24, 25 AND 26, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, AND SECTIONS 7 AND 18, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, BOSSIER PARISH, LOUISIANA, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on this 16th day of October, 2024, that from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a vehicle upon a 1.5-mile portion of Veterans Parkway, from Swan Lake Road to 400 feet north of Deen Point Road, located in Sections 13, 23, 24, 25, and 26, Township 19 North, Range 13 West, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, in excess of **forty-five (45) miles per hour**.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a vehicle upon a 2.37-mile portion of Veterans Parkway, from 400 feet north of Deen Point Road to Crouch Road, located in Section 13, Township 19 North, Range 13 West, and Sections 7 and 18, Township 19 North, Range 12 West, Bossier Parish, LA, in excess of **fifty (50) miles per hour**.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Rimmer, seconded by Mr. Salzer. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 16th day of October, 2024.
